Resourceful - because I spend a lot of my free time making things in my garage. I often use recycled timber to make things like chopping board.



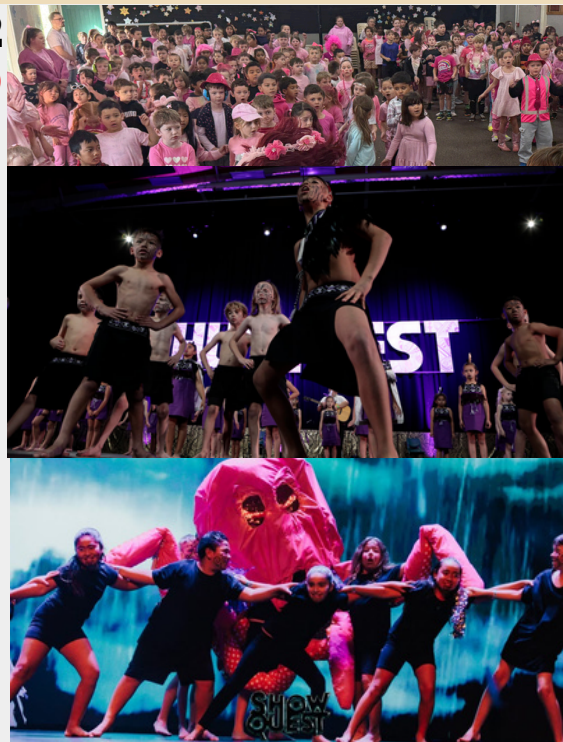

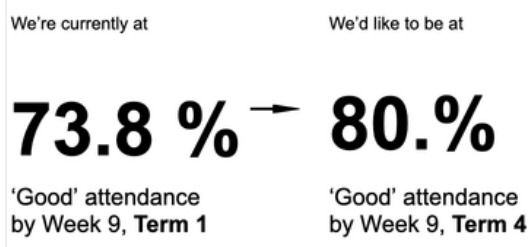
GOOD ATTENDANCE
Less than 5 days absence in a term

WORRYING ATTENDANCE
Up to 10 days absence in a term

CONCERNING ATTENDANCE
Up to 15 days absence in a term

VERY CONCERNING ATTENDANCE
15 days or more absence in a term

In line with the government’s target of 80% of students regularly attending school by 2030.



ATTENDANCE MANAGEMENT PLAN

At Fraser Crescent School we use the **Stepped Attendance Response** to guide when and how we respond to absences.

We understand that our tamariki often get unwell and need a few days to recover. Sometimes things pop up unexpectedly and absences are required. That is why we begin to look at a response or plan after 5 days of absence within a term.

In line with the government's target of 80% of students regularly attending school, on the left you will see what percentage of our students have taken less than 5 days off this term.

This is not far off our end of year goal and an improvement since last year!
