MATARIKI MĀ PUANGA

In Aotearoa, the rising of Matariki in midwinter signals the start of the Māori New Year — a sacred time for reflection, renewal, and reconnection.

When the stars appear in the early morning sky (just before sunrise), it marks a new beginning — a time to mourn loved ones who have passed, practice gratitude, and prepare for the year to come. Each year, this celestial event offers a powerful reminder of our place in the natural world and the importance of whānau, whakapapa (genealogy), and whenua (land).
